VIP TRANSPORT EXCEEDS BOOKING GOALS BY TWO MILLION DOLLARS AS AGENT FOR MAYFLOWER

ST. LOUIS -- On June 7, VIP Transport, Inc. and VIP Transport East, Inc., celebrated their one-year anniversary as agents for Mayflower Transit, one of the nation's oldest and largest van lines.
